84. NARRATIVE OF THE FACTUAL BASIS FOR PROBABLE CAUSE: The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the heretofore named defendant did commit the violations of law as stated above and the factual basis for this belief is as follows:

Your Affiant is Law Enforcement Inspector Tracy Burge of the Office of Inspector General, Florida Department of Corrections.

Your Affiant has probable cause to believe between the dates of November 2, 2019, and April 2, 2020, Correctional Officer Naudea Thompson (SS#), who works at Northwest Florida Reception Center, did commit the criminal offenses of Introduction of Contraband into/onto a State Prison through digital communications in violation of s. 944.47(1)(a)(1), Fla. Stat., and Unlawful use of a two-way communication device in violation of s. 934.215, Fla. Stat., when she used her mobile device to send emails (written communication) to Inmate Eugene Ward DC# K87633, and Inmate Brye Jenkins DC# C09772 via a fictitious JPay account.

JPay is a privately held corrections-related service provider based in the United States with its headquarters in Miramar, Florida. The company contracts with state Departments of Correction (DOC), county jails, and private federal prisons to provide technologies and services including money transfer, email, video visitation and parole and probation payments to approximately 1.5 million inmates throughout 35 states.

On or about March 24, 2020, information was received by your Affiant, via JPay, which indicated Inmate Ward and Inmate Jenkins had been corresponding with Tiffany Jenkins, JPay Customer I.D. 24439593. Customer Jenkins' Thompson. An additional address used for JPay Customer I.D. 2449593 was 2217 Topaz Road, Cottondale FL, which was found to be fictitious and did not exist.

Ongoing reviews of the JPay account revealed several changes had been made to the contact information for Customer I.D. 24439593, which coincided with the date Officer Thompson had been placed on No Inmate Contact as a result of this investigation.

A review of the JPay letters between November 2, 2019, through April 2, 2020, sent under the Customer Account ID # 24439593 revealed three hundred thirty-two (332) letters had been sent to Inmate Ward and nine (9) letters had been sent to Inmate Jenkins.

Video attachments found underJPay Customer Account ID # 24439593 revealed one (1) video had been sent with letter ID 756663508 to Inmate Ward. The video message recorded only a female's voice due to the camera being directed at a wall/ceiling. The voice was later identified as Officer Thompson by Major W. Schwarz and Captain A. Littles and was sent on March 13, 2020, from Internet Protocol (IP) address 71.220.2.90.

The content of the JPay letters contained conversations of a personal nature and indicated Officer Thompson and Inmate Ward loved each other, wished to get married, wished to have a baby together, and talked about having sex. As the JPay conversations progressed, Inmate Ward began to refer to the minor child of Officer Thompson as his and at one-point wished her a happy birthday, which coincided with Officer Thompson's actual birthday.

Throughout the JPay letter histories, both Officer Thompson and Inmate Ward made references to "visitation." A review of Inmate Ward's Departmental Approved Visitation revealed he did not have a visitation history. The Roster Management Work History, the Departmental post assignment data, of Officer Thompson, indicated she was on duty "visitation."

A series of JPay letters dated February 1, 2020 and February 2, 2020, alluded to the fact that sexual relations had already taken place between Officer Thompson and Inmate Ward. Officer Thompson mentioned

Ward questioned if he was going to be a "step-dad," and Officer Thompson asked Inmate Ward if he used a specific sex practice that would not prevent pregnancy because if he did, they needed to talk.

Officer Thompson on her Departmental employment application. A subpoena was submitted to Cellco Partnership/Verizon Wireless requesting the subscriber information for the above IP addresses. The subpoena identified the telephone number was the phone number that utilized the IP addresses reflected in JPay under Customer ID# 24439593. The telephone number (utilized JPay via the subpoenaed IP addresses a total of one hundred fifty-eight (158) times. The telephone number connected to JPay Customer ID #24439593 matched the People First information for Officer Thompson.

Warden Michael Mashburn indicated there were some circumstances when a staff member would need to request permission to write to an inmate, i.e. when a family member was incarcerated; however, Officer Thompson had not requested permission or disclosed any such relationship to Warden Mashburn, and he had not given Officer Thompson permission to write to any inmate.

Inmate Ward declined to provide or confirm any information.

Inmate Jenkins was shown one of the first letters written to him from the customer Tiffany Jenkins which stated, "This is Pineapples." Inmate Jenkins confirmed the letter was written to him on his JPay account. Inmate Jenkins stated he knew Officer Thompson as Pineapples, and over the course of time and talking in the dormitory he and Officer Thompson had become friends.
