84. NARRATIVE OF THE FACTUAL BASIS FOR PROBABLE CAUSE: The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the heretofore named defendant did commit the violations of law as stated above and the factual basis for this belief is as follows:

Your Affiant is Inspector James K. Maloney of the Office of the Inspector General, Florida Department of Corrections.
Your Affiant has probable cause to believe that on September 13, 2018, at the Walton Correctional Institution, in DeFuniak Springs Walton County, Florida, Inmate Terry Norris, DC #X11405, did make written threats to harm (victim), by writing an Inmate Request, addressed to the classification building and Fuck you up!", in violation of F.S.S. 838.021(3)(b), Corruption by threat against public servant.
On November 30, 2018, (victim) provided a digitally recorded interview, while at the Walton Correctional Institution, which revealed was informed about an Inmate Request addressed to her, which made threats by Inmate Norris to buy the biggest knife and come to the classification building and "fuck" her up. advised she became fearful that Inmate Norris was going to kill her. advised the only interaction she remembered having with Inmate Norris was when she heard a DR (Disciplinary Report) during a DR hearing where she found Inmate Norris guilty and when she makes her rounds in H-Dormitory and Y-Dormitory to pick up Grievances.
On November 30, 2018, Classification Officer Kerri Shirah (witness) provided a digitally recorded interview, while at the Walton Correctional Institution, which revealed Classification Officer Shirah received an Inmate Request addressed to written by Inmate Norris, on September 13, 2018. Officer Shirah did not remember how she received the Inmate Request, but it was hand delivered by one of the classification secretaries or was placed in her box due to the inmate's number being assigned to her. CLO Shirah advised she read the Inmate Request and notified and her supervisor about the threat.
On November 30, 2018, Inmate Terry Norris (suspect) provided a digitally recorded, post-Miranda, interview, while at the Walton Correctional Institution, which revealed Inmate Norris initially advised he did not know but later remembered she heard a Disciplinary Report, that he was issued, during DR Court. Inmate Norris was presented the Inmate Request, he looked at it, and then asked, "What about it? What you asking me, can I explain it?". Inmate Norris then advised, "that has already put me on

Close Custody Management", at which time it was explained the potential criminal charges for Threats to Officials. Inmate Norris then invoked his Miranda Rights and did not wish to answer any further questions.

On January 18, 2019, Evidence Items/Exhibits #1 (copy of Inmate Request containing written threat) and #2 (known writing samples of Inmate Norris) and on February 5, 2019, Evidence Items/Exhibits #3 (original of Item/Exhibit #1) and #4 (known writing samples of Inmate Norris) were submitted to the FDLE laboratory for handwriting analysis. The analysis revealed the following:

Visual and microscopic examinations of Exhibits 2(1-3), 2(4)a, 2(4)b, 2(5), 3a, and 4(1-3) were conducted. Exhibit 3a was also compared with Exhibits 2(1-3), 2(4)a, 2(4)b, 2(5), and 4(1-3). It was determined that the writer of Exhibits 2(1-3), 2(4)a, 2(4)b, 2(5), and 4(1-3) (Terry Norris) wrote (1) the questioned handwritten entries on Exhibit 3a. The writer of Exhibits 2(1-3), 2(4)a, 2(4)b, 2(5), and 4(1-3) (Terry Norris) highly probably (2) wrote the questioned handwritten signature on Exhibit 3a; however, due to an insufficient amount of comparable known writing, the evidence falls short of that necessary to support a conclusive opinion. Definition: 1 Identification - The analyst is certain, based on the evidence contained in the handwriting, that there is agreement in the individualizing characteristics and there are no significant, inexplicable differences between the questioned and known writings; the writer of the known material also wrote the questioned material. 2 Highly Probable - The evidence is very persuasive, yet some critical feature or quality is missing so that an identification is not in order; however, the examiner is virtually certain that the questioned and known writings were written by the same individual.

Inmate Norris was received at Walton Correctional Institution in DeFuniak Springs, Walton County, Florida, on July 26, 2018, where he remained, uninterrupted, until December 18, 2018.

Your Affiant respectfully submits that probable cause has been established that Inmate Terry Norris did, at Walton Correctional Institution, in DeFuniak Springs, Walton County, Florida, commit the criminal offense of Corruption by threat against public servant in violation of F.S.S. 838.021(3)(b).
