
WHEREAS, the Court finds from the facts alleged in said complaint that there is probable cause that said offense was committed and that said Defendant committed them.

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Your Affiant is Law Enforcement Senior Inspector Steven Donaldson of the Office of the Inspector General, Florida Department of Corrections.

Your Affiant has probable cause to believe that from December 23, 2019 - January 26, 2020, FDC Correctional Officer Kayla J. Kitler DOB [REDACTED] did commit the crimes of; 6 counts of Florida State Statute 944.47(1)(a)1 Introduction or possession of certain articles unlawful written or recorded communication or currency, 3 counts of Florida State Statute 944.47(1)(a)4 Introduction or possession of certain articles, any controlled substance as defined in s. 893.02(4) or any prescription or nonprescription drug having a hypnotic, stimulating, or depressing effect on Florida Department of Corrections Property and Florida State Statute 777.04 Attempts, solicitation, and conspiracy, of the introduction of contraband into a state prison.

Officer Kitler created a fictitious J-Pay account on December 23, 2019, and had a total of 99 communication interaction messages to / from Inmate [REDACTED] until January 26, 2020. Of those written communications documented Officer Kitler sent 40 written communication messages to Inmate [REDACTED] and received 59 communication messages from Inmate [REDACTED]. Officer Kitler also sent two money / currency transactions of \$50 each to Inmate [REDACTED] on January 7, 2020, at 10:51 AM and 12:57 PM. The last four digits of the Visa card used was ( [REDACTED] Inmate [REDACTED] admitted he was receiving electronic communication via the fictitious name with Officer Kitler as well as smuggled contraband from her. Officer Kitler supervised Inmate [REDACTED] in L Dormitory eleven times from November 15, 2019, – December 9, 2019.

The address on the factious J-Pay account "Mary J King" was the same as listed for Correctional Officer Kayla J. Kitler [REDACTED] per FDC personnel records. DHSMV records currently list Officer Kitler's Florida driver's license address as [REDACTED]. DHSMV records also list this Georgia address in January 6, 2020, for Officer Kitler.

On April 24, 2020, a sworn recorded interview was conducted with Inmate [REDACTED] at the Florida State Prison. Inmate [REDACTED] indicated Correctional Officer Kayla J Kitler is also Mary J King the person who sent him electronic communication messages in the J-Pay computer system while he is in prison. Inmate [REDACTED] advised Officer Kitler is sending him messages and photographs, because she loves him. Inmate [REDACTED] explained Officer Kitler talks about their relationship (Inmate [REDACTED] and Officer Kitler) and talks about sexual relations. Inmate [REDACTED] indicated Officer Kitler told him "that's what the bathrooms are for and the laundry room". Inmate [REDACTED] explained Officer Kitler talked a lot about drama going on at work and how she hated her job as a correctional officer as well as who was snitching on whom. Inmate [REDACTED] admitted Officer Kitler smuggled cigarettes to him on three separate occasions. Inmate [REDACTED] explained Officer Kitler brought him four packs on each said occasion. Inmate [REDACTED] advised Officer Kitler took off the brown cigarette filters and wrapped the cigarettes in plastic cellophane and electrical tape. Inmate [REDACTED] also indicated Officer Kitler gave him her 2019, Thanksgiving meal consisting of mashed potatoes, turkey, and macaroni and cheese. Inmate [REDACTED] advised the cigarettes Officer Kitler smuggled to him were worth a total of \$600 in the prison for the twelve packs. Inmate [REDACTED] Indicated Officer Kitler lived in [REDACTED] when she was in a relationship with him. Inmate [REDACTED] indicated Officer Kitler took a photograph of a tattoo she got with Inmate [REDACTED] name "[REDACTED]" on her person and sent the photograph to [REDACTED] via a J-Pay electronic message. Inmate [REDACTED] described the electronic messages were like boyfriend / girlfriend relationship. Inmate [REDACTED] indicated the J-Pay messages in this case are true and correct. Inmate [REDACTED] advised Officer Kitler talked about having sex in the bathroom with him and marriage. Inmate [REDACTED] indicated Officer Kitler smuggled him the three-separate drops of cigarettes in October, November and December 2019.

On August 20, 2020, a sworn recorded interview was conducted with Correctional Lieutenant Mark Avery. Lieutenant Avery indicated while reviewing J-Pay emails to inmates in the prison he observed suspicious emails to Inmate [REDACTED] housed at the Florida State Prison West Unit. Lieutenant Avery advised he observed J-Pay email from a Mary J King to Inmate [REDACTED]. The emails were of a personal and romantic nature ranging from "I love you" to marriage and recently having each other's name tattooed on each other. Officer Kitler aka Mary J. King



emailed a tattoo she had done on January 4, 2020, and sent a picture of the tattoo on January 14, 2020, to Inmate [REDACTED]. In one email Inmate [REDACTED] stated that they have been talking for a short while, seeing each other on various occasions since December 23, 2019, which is when the Mary J King J-Pay account was set up. Lieutenant Avery indicated Mary J King was not listed to visit Inmate [REDACTED] so how would she see Inmate [REDACTED]. Lieutenant Avery indicated the name Mary J King was fictitious, so he searched the address on an open source the address given on the J-Pay account of [REDACTED]. Lieutenant Avery indicated the address came back to Correctional Officer Kayla J. Kitler who was working at the Florida State Prison West Unit. Lieutenant Avery advised he reviewed the dates of the emails and Officer Kitler's work schedule to include time at the prison working, days off and days she called in. Lieutenant Avery advised the emails indicated Officer Kitler was smuggling contraband into the prison. Lieutenant Avery explained Inmate [REDACTED] wrote in an email to Officer Kitler that he "is out of cigs this morning, but that tomorrow morning will be a different story". Lieutenant Avery also explained Inmate [REDACTED] instructs Officer Kitler to send four "toys" (slang for cell phones) to 1414 Palmer Street Jacksonville, Florida 32233 an address that belongs to Samantha Lester the girlfriend of Inmate Duston Bond DC# 132640 [REDACTED]. Lieutenant Avery advised Inmate Bond is involved in the introduction and sale of contraband in the prison currently in confinement for cell phone possession. Lieutenant Avery indicated he questioned Inmate [REDACTED] about having a relationship with Officer Kitler and [REDACTED] admitted to the relationship with Kitler. Lieutenant Avery advised Inmate [REDACTED] displayed a tattoo on his ring finger of "Kayle" and [REDACTED] told Officer Kitler he did that for her. Lieutenant Avery indicated an inventory of Inmate [REDACTED] property revealed a piece of paper with the address of Officer Kitler of [REDACTED]. Inmate [REDACTED] admitted to Lieutenant Avery the address belonged to Officer Kitler. Lieutenant Avery indicated Inmate [REDACTED] told him Officer Kitler brought him a Thanksgiving meal consisting of turkey, mashed potatoes and macaroni and cheese from outside the prison in November 2019. Lieutenant Avery advised Inmate [REDACTED] admitted to receiving cigarettes from Officer Kitler which in turn he sold to other inmates. Lieutenant Avery indicated Officer Kitler supervised Inmate [REDACTED] as a housing officer at the Florida State Prison West Unit. Lieutenant Avery indicated Officer Kitler discussed in the emails taking showers together with Inmate [REDACTED] as well as other sexual activities and sexual preferences. Lieutenant Avery indicated some messages Officer Kitler sent discussed having children together with Inmate [REDACTED]. Lieutenant Avery explained Officer Kitler's fictitious J-Pay account was started in December 2019, but the relationship was started before that reflecting back to the Thanksgiving meal, she introduced into the prison for Inmate [REDACTED].

On August 30, 2020, a sworn recorded interview was conducted with Correctional Captain Julie Beighley. Captain Beighley indicated she supervised Officer Kitler at the Florida State Prison West Unit and was responsible to update officer's emergency contact information to include the home address. Captain Beighley advised she asked Officer Kitler's what her address was and Officer Kitler alluded she was having to move but has not moved yet. Captain Beighley explained that Officer Kitler said she lived in Georgia but declined to give her address and acted suspicious. Captain Beighley indicated the conversation took place before January 28, 2020.

Your Affiant respectfully submits that probable cause has been established that Correctional Officer Kayla J. Kitler did commit the criminal offense of: 6 counts of Florida State Statute 944.47(1)(a)1 Introduction or possession of certain articles unlawful written or recorded communication or currency, 3 counts of Florida State Statute 944.47(1)(a)4 Introduction or possession of certain articles, Any controlled substance as defined in s. 893.02(4) or any prescription or nonprescription drug having a hypnotic, stimulating, or depressing effect, and Florida State Statute 777.04 Attempts, solicitation, and conspiracy, of the introduction of contraband into a state prison.
