84. NARRATIVE OF THE FACTUAL BASIS FOR PROBABLE CAUSE: The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the heretofore named defendant did commit the violations of law as stated above and the factual basis for this belief is as follows:

Your Affiant is Senior Inspector William "Eddie" Dalton of the Office of the Inspector General, Florida Department of Corrections.

Your Affiant has probable cause to believe on or about December 26, 2021, Jackson Correctional Institution (Jackson C.I.) Correctional Sergeant Rebekah Quattlebaum (Sergeant Quattlebaum), in the County of Jackson and the State of Florida, did commit the criminal offense of one (1) count of Conspiracy to Introduce Contraband (Tobacco) in violation of §. 777.04/944.47(1)(a)(4), Florida Statute, when Sergeant Quattlebaum did actually and intentionally conspire with inmate(s) to introduce contraband into the secure perimeter of Jackson C.I. to Inmate Anthony Lewis DC#S25402 (Inmate Lewis) and Inmate Marquis McCorvey DC#V46695 (Inmate McCorvey); and two (2) counts of the criminal offense of Interference with Prisoners, in violation of §. 944.39, Florida Statute, when Sergeant Quattlebaum engaged in an inappropriate relationship with Inmate Lewis and Inmate McCorvey who were under her direct supervision and while incarcerated within the Florida Department of Corrections, and while doing so allowed Inmate Lewis and Inmate McCorvey to violate laws of the State of Florida and rules of the Department of Corrections.

Sergeant Quattlebaum began her career as a Correctional Officer with Florida Department of Corrections at Jackson C.I. in June of 2015. During Sergeant Quattlebaum's employment at Jackson C.I., she completed New Employee Training. As part of this training, Sergeant Quattlebaum received training related to Equal Employment Opportunity & anti-harassment, instructions for reporting inappropriate inmate behavior, rules, procedures, policies related to new employees, and staff offender relationships were strictly prohibited.

On or about January 6, 2022, the Florida Department of Corrections, Office of the Inspector General initiated a criminal investigation after allegations were made indicating Sergeant Quattlebaum was introducing contraband to inmates housed at Jackson C.I.

Sworn testimony was obtained from the time Sergeant Quattlebaum worked there. The alleged on December 25 and 26, 2021, Sergeant Quattlebaum introduced cigarettes, "Molly", and marijuana in a blue glove into the secure perimeter of Jackson C.I.

According to the secure perimeter of Jackson C.I.

Fixed wing video confirmed on December 26, 2021, at approximately 13:54, Sergeant Quattlebaum exited the secure perimeter of Jackson C.I. Sergeant Quattlebaum went to her vehicle in the parking lot and returned to the institution at approximately 14:03. When Sergeant Quattlebaum entered the secure perimeter, she circumvented policy mandated entrance and exit procedures by not being subjected to a pat search and/or metal detector screening before returning to F-dormitory.

After returning to F-dormitory, at approximately 14:42, Sergeant Quattlebaum could be seen on fixed wing video giving Inmate Anthony Lewis DC#S25402 a blue glove in the common area of the dormitory.

After providing Inmate Lewis with the blue glove, Sergeant Quattlebaum could be seen carrying another a blue glove while conducting her rounds in F-dormitory, wing At approximately 14:43:49, Sergeant Quattlebaum was standing in the threshold of cell 207, when Inmate McCorvey entered the cell, narrowly passing between Sergeant Quattlebaum and the door frame. Upon exiting the cell, Sergeant Quattlebaum is no longer carrying the blue glove.
