COUNT I: Torri S Waldrup, between May 1, 2018 and May 31, 2018, in the County of Jackson and State of Florida, did unlawfully agree, conspire, combine or confederate to unlawfully introduce into or upon the grounds of a state correctional institution, cellular telephone, or take or attempt to take or send or attempt to send therefrom, written or electronic communication, a contraband article, in the County of and State of Florida, contrary to Florida Statutes 777.04(3) and 944.47. (F3 - L3)

COUNT II: Torri S Waldrup, between May 1, 2018 and May 31, 2018, in the County of Jackson and State of Florida, did unlawfully use a two-way communications device, including, but not limited to, a portable two-way wireless communications device, to facilitate or further the commission of, a felony offense, contrary to Florida Statute 934.215. (F3 - L4)

COUNT III: Torri S Waldrup, between May 1, 2018 and May 31, 2018, in the County of Jackson and State of Florida, did unlawfully agree, conspire, combine or confederate to unlawfully introduce into or upon the grounds of a state correctional institution, cellular telephone, or take or attempt to take or send or attempt to send therefrom, cellular telephone, a contraband article, in the County of and State of Florida, contrary to Florida Statutes 777.04(3) and 944.47. (F3 - L3)



84, NARRATIVE OF THE FACTUAL BASIS FOR PROBABLE CAUSE: The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the heretofore named defendant did commit the violations of law as stated above and the factual basis for this belief is as follows:

Your Affiant is Senior Inspector Jerry Basford of the Office of the Inspector General, Florida Department of Corrections.

Your Affiant has probable cause to believe on or about May 2, 2018 through May 12, 2018, Torri S. Waldrup ("Ms. Waldrup") and Sheila Marie Mitchell ("Ms. Mitchell") conspired with each other, Kayla Joy Bryars ("Ms. Bryars") and inmates housed at Graceville Work Camp to arrange the delivery of prepaid cellular telephones for the purpose of those telephones being introduced into Graceville Work Camp.

On or about June 26, 2018, a contraband cellular telephone was recovered at Graceville Work Camp. Ms. Bryars was identified as routinely communicating with Inmate Beau Emley using the contraband cellular telephone beginning in November 2017. Much of their conversation involved the arrangement of contraband deliveries to inmate work squad locations in Jackson County, Florida, where work squad inmates would collect the contraband and introduce the contraband into Graceville Work Camp where Inmate Emley was housed.

After review of the contraband device's data, communication with Ms. Waldrup was also identified. Ms. Waldrup's telephone number was saved in the contraband device as "Tor" and is the same telephone number listed for Ms. Waldrup on her Florida Department of Corrections visitor profile for Inmate Jason Waterhouse ("Inmate Waterhouse"), who was housed at Graceville Work Camp at the time. The text message communication on the contraband device, including the transfer of money as payment for contraband, further confirms Ms. Waldrup's use of the telephone number.

On or about May 2, 2018, at the inmates' request, Ms. Waldrup provided the inmate(s) with a telephone number, 276-395-1449, identified through their communication as Ms. Mitchell. According to Department records, Ms. Mitchell has a visitor profile listing her relationship with Inmate Waterhouse as "Personal Friend." Ms. Mitchell provided the inmates with her address and agreed to receive packages on their behalf.

On or about May 10, 2018, Ms. Mitchell accepted a parcel on behalf of the inmates. Ms. Mitchell confirmed her receipt of one parcel containing at least one prepaid cellular telephone. There was also indication of a second package to be delivered to Ms. Mitchell the following day. Ms. Mitchell was provided money by the inmates through money transfer and under the direction of the inmates, purchased additional cellular telephones, frisbees, adhesive and tape. Ms. Mitchell was then instructed by the inmate on how to package the cellular telephones in a manner to disguise them for introduction purposes. Ms. Mitchell's packaging of the cellular telephones was documented through digital images exchanged with the inmates. One of the images provided by Ms. Mitchell was forwarded to Ms. Bryars. The conversation indicates there are twelve cellular telephones.

On or about May 12, 2018, Ms. Waldrup is reminded to make sure she gets the frisbees, tape and glue from her (Ms. Mitchell). Within two hours of the message being sent to Ms. Ms. Waldrup she indicates in a text message she "got the stuff." Arrangements are then made for Ms. Waldrup to drive the telephones to a location halfway between McIntosh, Alabama and Dothan, Alabama and provide them to Ms. Bryars. A series of text messages and images exchanged indicate the bundles of cellular telephones were provided to Ms. Bryars. The conversation related to the cellular telephones concludes with an image sent by Ms. Bryars of two of the bundles of contraband cellular telephones on the ground as if to show they were delivered.

It is evident through text message communication and digital images that Ms. Waldrup, Ms. Mitchell and Ms. Bryars all actively and willing participated in the receipt and transfer prepaid cellular telephones packaged in a manner consistent with the introduction of contraband into a State Correctional Institution.

Your Affiant submits probable cause exists in this instance that Ms. Waldrup committed the criminal offenses of: Conspiracy to Introduce Contraband, Cellular Telephones in violation of s. 777.04(3) / 944.47(1)(a)(6) when she knowingly and intentionally conspired with Ms. Mitchell and Ms. Bryars and inmates to transfer the already packaged contraband cellular telephones to Ms. Bryars; Introduction of Contraband, Written/Recorded Communication in violation of s. 777.04(3) / 944.47(1)(a)(1) when Ms. Waldrup did knowingly and intentionally transmit written/recorded electric communication and images to a contraband cellular telephone within the secure perimeter of a State Correctional Institution; and Unlawful Use of a two-way communication device in violation of s. 934.215 when Ms. Waldrup did knowingly and intentionally utilized a cellular telephone to arrange the meeting and exchange of contraband cellular telephones from Ms. Mitchell to Ms. Bryars and to transmit contraband communication in the secure perimeter of a State Correctional Institution.

Your Affiant submits probable cause exists in this instance that Ms. Mitchell committed the criminal offenses of: Conspiracy to Introduce Contraband, Cellular Telephones in violation of s. 777.04(3) / 944.47(1)(a)(6) when she knowingly and intentionally conspired with Ms. Mitchell and Ms. Bryars and inmates to received, purchase and package contraband cellular telephones; Introduction of Contraband, Written/Recorded Communication in violation of s. 777.04(3) / 944.47(1)(a)(1) when Ms. Mitchell did knowingly and intentionally transmit written/recorded electric communication images to a contraband cellular telephone within the secure perimeter of a Correctional Institution; and Unlawful Us two-way communication device in violation of s. 934.215 when Ms. Mitchell did knowingly and intentionally utilized a cellular telephone to arrange the receipt and purchase of contraband cellular telephones and the exchange of contraband cellular telephones and to transmit contraband communication in the secure perimeter of a State Correctional Institution.

Your Affiant requests an arrest warrant be issued for TORRI S. WALDRUP, DOB 11/04/1989, LKA 69 3-D Road, McIntosh, Alabama, for one count each of a violation of s. 944.47 (1)(a)(1), the laws related introducing contraband communication; a violation of s. 934.215, the laws related to the unlawful use of a cellular telephone; and one count of s. 777.04(3) / 944.47 (1)(a)(6), the laws relating to conspiracy to introduce contraband cellular telephones.

Your Affiant requests an arrest warrant be issued for SHEILA MARIE MITCHELL, DOB 08/16/1975, LKA 15776 Citronell Road, Citronell, Alabama, for one count each of a violation of s. 944.47 (1)(a)(1), the laws related introducing contraband communication; a violation of s. 934.215, the laws related to the unlawful use of a cellular telephone; and one count of s. 777.04(3) / 944.47 (1)(a)(6), the laws relating to conspiracy to introduce contraband cellular telephones.
